
Functions

To convert the 991MF lock case to specific functions you will require the appropriate cams/ cam adaptors (shown below). Vestibule and Combination locks convert to V and C series respectively, with the exception of Passage (C57) and Exit(V55) locks (no locking bar).

The required cam number for each function is shown next to the cylinder or turn in the chart adjacent. Orders for configured locks are supplied with indicated cam(s) and adaptor(s).




